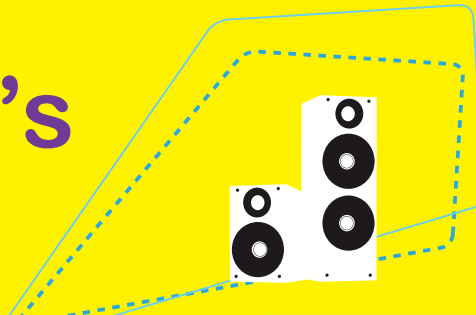

Our youth workers will take us seriously and treat us with respect

We will be treated equally and not discriminated against because of our age, gender, sexuality, race, religion, culture, ability, class or appearance

Our youth workers should be friendly and easy to talk to but will also challenge attitudes and behaviour that could upset or offend others.

We will be involved in decision-making at all levels of the youth service, in our youth groups and at Area and City level. We will have opportunities to assist the City Council with its decision-making.

Social and educational activities based on our wants and needs will be planned with us. These will be in a variety of settings, in youth centres and on the streets, and will be fun and challenging.

Information about us will stay confidential unless we have been told otherwise. We will be able to see all information that is kept about us.

Our youth workers will do their best to give us reliable and confidential help, information and advice.

We will be safe from harm when involved in youth work activities and settings.

Encourage each other to behave in responsible ways.
